TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The hire agreement forms part of these terms and conditions.

The term 'Old School Camper Hire' or 'us' or 'we' refers to Old School Camper Hire. Our company ICO registration number is **Z2027042**. The term 'you' or 'hirer' or 'driver' refers to you the hirer.

Please be advised if you do not adhere to the Terms & Conditions regarding Driver Age, Payment, Driving Licences & history, Identification required and Rental Payment Terms when collecting the camper our Cancellation Policy will be enforced.

- When you sign the form on the last page you accept the conditions set out in this rental agreement.
- We will carry out an Anti-Money Laundering check against the name and address of the hirer after we have received a deposit. We will utilise a licensed credit reference agency who will make a record of this search as an anti-money laundering search. This record will not be shared with other businesses and will not form the basis of any subsequent credit related activity.
- Please read this agreement carefully. If there is anything you do not understand or do not agree with, please contact us at Old School Camper Hire.

Insurance

- Driver must be between the age of 25 and 70.
- Driver must have a valid UK driving licence for at least 2 years.
- If your licence has any penalties or endorsements there will be an additional insurance cost.
- One named driver is included in the cost of the hire.
- Insurance only covers road liability and the van itself. This does not cover the contents or personal belongings. (Please take additional travel insurance to cover theft/loss of any belongings and personal injury of any kind).
- Driver must provide both parts of the driving license when collecting the van. Failure to produce both valid counter parts will result in you not being able to hire the vehicle and you will not be refunded the cost of the hire. We cannot accept an expired driving license.
- If the driver has been banned from driving for a DD, DR or UT offence, or has been disqualified for 12 months or more this may affect the premium or it may affect you not being able to be insured.
- Insurance is only valid for the named driver for the duration of the hire.
- If you are running late on the day of return you must inform us immediately and an additional charge will be applied. (Please see Rental Agreement)

Excess

- The excess of £1250 in case of accidental damage, fire, theft or third party damage is the responsibility of the hirer.

Deposit

- A £550 deposit will be taken on collection of the vehicle and will be refunded within 24hrs of return of the vehicle as long as the rental terms are met.
- A full inventory will be carried out prior to the rental in the presence of the hirer to cover both parties. A signed copy will be given to the hirer.

Payments

- A non refundable deposit of £150 will be required to secure the booking reservation.
- The full amount is required 6 weeks prior to the date of rental.
- If the booking is made less than 6 weeks of the rental date, the full amount must be paid immediately.

Cancellation / Refund

- If a cancellation is made before the full payment is due (6 weeks prior to rental) the hirer will lose their £150 deposit.
- If a cancellation is made between 6 – 3 weeks prior to rental 50% of the rental cost will be refunded.
- If a cancellation is made within 21 days or under no refund will be given.
- There will be no refund in the eventuality of early return of the vehicle.

*** We strongly advise you to take out travel insurance to cover any cancellations / early returns.**

Collection of vehicle

Identification required for UK Resident. When collecting the vehicle, the Hire/Driver must present:

- i. 2 forms of ID (passport and utilities bill - at least one confirming home address) plus
- ii. a credit or debit card in their own name (see above)
- iii. a valid driving license (both parts of the new UK License are required)- We cannot accept an expired driving license

If you do not arrive to collect your vehicle (no show):

- i. Unless you have cancelled your reservation in accordance with the above terms, if you do not collect your vehicle at the time specified no refund will be made.
- ii. Old School Camper Hire will, however, hold your rental vehicle available for you for 4 hours after the time of the reservation.

Mileage

- An agreed travel distance is included in the standard rental fee. Additional mileage is charged at **50p** per mile. (Please see website for more information)

Breakdown

- We have maintained the vehicle to recommended standard. We assure you that the vehicle is roadworthy and suitable for renting at the start of the rental period.
- In the unlikely event that you break down, all our vehicles have the benefit of full road side breakdown cover.
- All our vehicles are in full working order and are regularly serviced by a VW specialist.
- We will not accept any liability for loss or claim as a result of a breakdown, accident or any other cause.
- If an unfortunate event, such as a breakdown, does occur, we will use our best endeavours to try and repair or replace the vehicle.
- Unless the vehicle shows any obvious signs of abuse we will refund you for any days hire lost as a result of a breakdown. Such refunds are entirely at our discretion.
- If you have an accident you should contact the necessary authorities and get the names and addresses of everyone involved, including witnesses.
- If you are in an accident you should:
 - i. Secure the vehicle
 - ii. Inform the police of anyone who is injured or if there is a disagreement over who is responsible
 - iii. Inform Old School Camper Hire as soon as possible.
 - iv. On return, complete out our Accident Report Form.
- We cannot be held responsible for any other loss or cost incurred as a result of your trip being cut short for any reason.
- Due to the age of the vehicle(s) in the unlikely event of a breakdown or accident, Old School Camper Hire will make every effort to repair the vehicle or transfer the hirer to another vehicle so that the journey can continue and accept any reasonable costs incurred or a refund will be given. Old School Camper Hire cannot accept responsibility for missed connections and/or functions however caused.

*** We strongly advise you to take out travel insurance to cover any cancellations / early returns.**

Maintenance

- The hirer is responsible for conducting minor maintenance checks, throughout the hire period.
- Maintenance check includes:
 - i. Correct tyre pressure
 - ii. Daily oil and water checks together with a fan belt check

* If you are unfamiliar with the location of any of the above parts or the correct procedure for checking, you should request a demonstration from us prior to departure.

- Please react immediately to any red warning lights illuminated on the dashboard. Pull over in a safe place and seek assistance. See roadside assistance documentation for details.
- The hirer is responsible for regular vehicle checks, failing to do so may result in damage to the vehicle. Any cost incurred as a result of neglect will be charged to the hirer.
- Due to the age of the vehicle(s) in the unlikely event of a breakdown or accident, Old School Camper Hire will make every effort to repair the vehicle or transfer the hirer to another vehicle so that the journey can

continue and accept any reasonable costs incurred or a refund will be given. Old School Camper Hire cannot accept responsibility for missed connections and/or functions however caused.

Rental Agreement

- The vehicle will be returned with a full tank of petrol.
- If the vehicle is returned part full you will be charged for missing fuel at the end of the rental at the locally determined price. This charge will be deducted from your deposit.
- The vehicle is returned in the same condition as when rented out.
- The vehicle is returned undamaged and clean and meets the criteria of the inventory carried out prior to rental.
- All utensils and cooking appliances must be clean and ready for use otherwise an additional cleaning cost of £25 will be charged.
- Any missing utensils will be charged for the appropriate replacement cost.
- You will have the vehicle for the rental period shown in your Reservation Confirmation. If you do not return the vehicle back on time, or if you do not contact us and get our agreement to an extension of your rental, you are breaking the conditions of this agreement. The vehicle must be returned within the agreed times, failure to do so will incur a daily fee equivalent to a days hire. If you are late and it interferes with another booking further charges will be applied. Charges refer to the prices on the Old School Camper Hire website.
- We reserve the right to charge you for each day or part-day you retain the vehicle following the specified return date. Until we get the vehicle back we will charge you the daily rate specified on the rental agreement when you collect the vehicle.
- If the van is returned in an unreasonably clean condition a valeting charge of £40 will be deducted from your deposit.
- You must always take good care of the vehicle and the keys to the vehicle.
- You must not sell, rent or dispose of the vehicle or any of its parts. You must not give anyone any legal rights over the vehicle.
- You must always secure and lock the vehicle when you are not using it, and use any security device fitted to or supplied with the vehicle.
- You must always protect the vehicle against bad weather which can cause damage.
- You are responsible for any damage to the vehicle caused by hitting low-level objects, such as bridges or low branches.
- You must not let anyone work on the vehicle without our permission. If we do give you permission, we will only provide a refund for any repairs if you provide a valid VAT receipt.
- Strictly no smoking inside the vehicle, awnings or tent.
- The number of passengers per vehicle must be kept to the capacity of the vehicles. (The number of seats belts)
- Unleaded fuel only must be used.
- The hirer is responsible for using the correct fuel (Unleaded) and will accept full responsible for any costs associated with repairs required due to the supply of incorrect/unsuitable fuel.
- No pets unless by prior arrangements in which case a £20 valeting charge will be incurred.

- Do not leave any valuables on show inside the vehicle when unattended other than fixed items.
- Do not leave the CD/radio facia on view when unattended.
- Do not leave the keys in the ignition when unattended.
- The hirer will be responsible for the loss of keys.
- You must not use the vehicle for hire or reward.
- You must not use the vehicle for racing, pacemaking, testing the vehicle reliability and speed or teaching someone to drive.
- Do not leave the vehicle unlocked when unattended.
- Do not leave the vehicle unattended without using the steering lock.
- No driving the vehicle off public roads or on roads unsuitable for vehicles.
- No driving the vehicle on beaches.
- No driving the vehicle through water, i.e. rivers or sea.
- The hirer will not take the vehicle overseas - this agreement is limited to use in the UK only.
- The hirer is responsible for not driving the vehicle whilst under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- The hirer is responsible for abiding by the law for the duration of the rental period.
- You are must not use the vehicle for towing.
- The hirer/driver is responsible to not load the vehicle beyond the manufacturer maximum weight recommendations and make sure that any load is secured safely.
- The driver is responsible for any legal penalties, such as speeding fines, parking fines during the hire.
- The hirer is responsible for all fines, court costs and intended prosecutions for parking, traffic or other offences (including any costs which arise if the vehicle is clamped). You must pay the appropriate authority any fines and costs if and when the authority demands such payment.
- Only the named driver may drive the vehicle for the rental period.
- The hirer must collect and return the vehicle within the agreed times.
- The vehicle must not be driven over 60mph.
- The hirer will be responsible for the reasonable cost of repairing any extra damage which was not noted on our vehicle check form at the start of the agreement, whether you were at fault or not.
- Lost Belongings - While every effort will be made to return any items found in the vehicle(s), Old School Camper Hire will not accept any liability for any items lost by the hirer or its party whilst using its services.
- Photographs – Old school Camper Hire would like to take photographs at your event so they may be used on our website and promotional material. If you prefer these photo's not to be used then please let us know prior to the engagement.
- Old School Camper Hire reserves the right to vary the rates, terms and conditions, to refuse hire to any person without explanation or prior warning.

Governing Law

This agreement is governed by the Laws of England.
